Since 2007, Margaret has been helping AWI Chapters and individual firms increase their familiarity with USGBC's LEED building rating system. "Incorporating the aspects of woodwork into the requirements of LEED credits has been the challenge of custom woodwork firms this past decade. With USGBC's recent changes and with the potential changes to come for forest management designations in LEED Credits, AWI members have often felt uneasy about their role and responsibilities about participation," Fisher says. Margaret's two hour program will help you decide if LEED is right for you.
